

1. Any limousine built under a Ford QVM or Cadillac CMC scheme is automatically approved as a suitable vehicle.
2. Any limousine not built under a manufacturers approved scheme will be referred to VOSA for inspection and confirmation as to the safety and standard of the build quality who will then issue a certificate of suitability.
3. Age of limousine should not be considered as an impairment, as the Public Service Vehicle rules accept vehicles of any age. The safety of the vehicle will be the paramount consideration.
4. Limousines are easily identified and therefore the need for external identification plates is not required. However, "Executive Plates" will be required.
5. Inspections should be mandatory every 10 weeks as such vehicles have highly stressed brakes, steering and suspension.
6. Tyres should be of an appropriate weight loading for the limousine as approved by the Licensing Service.
7. Length of vehicle (stretch) Ford QVM limits the stretch to 120 inches and Cadillac CMC limits it to 130 inches All other vehicles will be considered on their own merits.
8. All front passenger seats should be removed to avoid the temptation to carry passengers in the offside front of a vehicle.
9. The inclusion or sale of alcohol in the vehicles must be covered by a separate licence.
