

Historic Viewpoints

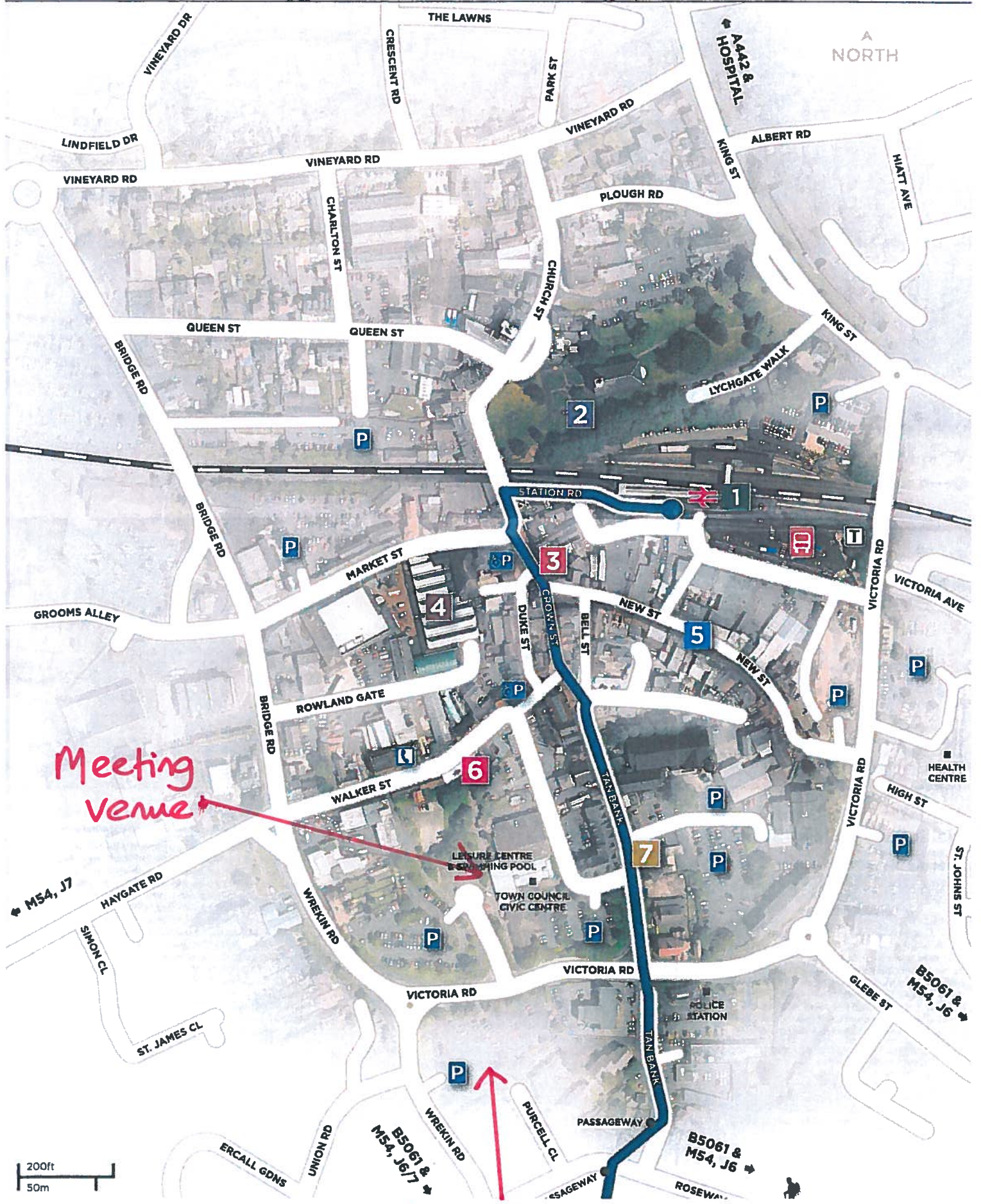
Use the numbered historic viewpoints to help you find your way around the town. The corresponding historical references will give an idea of some of the town's history, features and modern facilities.
