The landscape structure of the Site and the proposed planting is intended to provide an informal setting, responding positively to its edge of settlement location, softening and filtering views into the Site and incorporating wide landscape buffers along boundaries where appropriate

Landscape Strategy

- Perimeter structural vegetation to be retained, enhanced and reinforced and native species trees introduced to soften and filter views into the Site
- A sequence of publicly accessible green spaces centred on the existing hedgerows, trees and waterbodies within the Site, ensuring that the existing landscape structure is incorporated positively into the scheme, and assisting in integrating the scheme into its wider landscape
- Meadows and a naturalistic play space would be incorporated in the northern part of the Site
- Wide belts of reinforcement planting would be incorporated along the boundaries to the Windings
- Existing ponds to be retained and enhanced in accordance with ecological recommendations
- Proposed surface water attenuation features would provide storage capacity for the Site and provide additional habitat opportunities for biodiversity
- Proposed tree planting to include native species oak, field maple, goat willow, silver birch and hazel
- Proposed native species hedgerow to include hawthorn, hazel, holly and blackthorn
- A network of pedestrian paths through the Site would provide access to the areas of publicly accessible open space within the Site
