



Proposed Community Woodland

- Planted and managed with input from local community.
- Native tree species suitable to local area and other species of high biodiversity value.
- Matrix planting using an under-storey of native shrub species.
- Ground cover planting in and around a woodland glade area, with native species such as English Bluebells and Wood Anemones.
- Woodland glade with seating area and opportunity for community activities.
- Sinuous woodland trail.
- Potential for woodland sculptures.
- Hibernacula such as log piles to provide shelter for a range of wildlife.
- Signage and entrance features designed with input from local community.
